# PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

**Armchair Travel : King Arthur:** Join us as we examine the origins of the King Arthur mythos, how it evolved over time, regional variations of the tale, and the places connected to the legend.

**Armchair Travel : London:** Take a virtual tour through London! Reference librarians from St. Tammany Parish Library will take you on a tour of London while introducing you to library resources that can help you to begin your journey to traveling to other far off places.

**Ask a Reference Librarian:** A reference librarian will be available to assist patrons and answer questions.

**Computer Basics:** Do you need to learn how to use a computer? Are you unsure of computer terminology? Are you uncomfortable using the keyboard or the mouse? You will learn how to search for grantmakers who have funded organizations working on causes and with communities similar to those you serve.

**iPhone & iPad Basics:** A reference librarian will present information to help you use your iPhone or iPad. Please bring these items to class: your Apple ID and password; your iPhone and/or iPad.

**LLSBA/LEAP Legal Workshop Watch Party: Child Custody & Grandparents' Rights:** During this presentation, an attorney from Acadiana Legal Service Corporation will discuss what you need to know about child custody and grandparents rights. After the presentation, you can ask questions as time allows.
